Resolution Recommending Transfer of Funds in 2020 from the Iowa County Capital Projects Fund Balance for the Cost of a Vehicle for the Land Conservation Department

## TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, the Land Conservation Department is in need of an additional four-wheel drive vehicle for Farmland Preservation compliance reviews; design, survey, and construction oversight of cost-shared soil and water conservation practices; dam inspections and maintenance; addressing Notices of Discharge or complaints; and other landowner technical assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Long Range Planning Committee reviewed the Iowa County Capital Improvement Plan 2021-2025, which included a second vehicle for the Land Conservation Department; and

WHEREAS, the Long Range Planning Committee decided to transfer a vehicle from the Highway Department to the Land Conservation Department for the book value of the asset utilizing Capital Projects Fund Balance and;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT,** the Executive Committee does hereby recommend to the Iowa County Board of Supervisors a transfer of funds from the Iowa County Capital Projects Fund Balance to cover the cost of a vehicle for the Land Conservation Department in 2020 in the following 2020 account:
