## TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Law Enforcement Committee feels that two Sargeant positions are necessary to coordinate the daily operation of Sheriff's Deputies in law enforcement, investigate criminal and civil process, provide training, jail and court security, and in the absence of a ranking officer assumes responsibility for command; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Personnel Committee has reviewed the positions and does also recommend that two (2) Sargeant positions be created for a six month trial period, one for the second shift and one for the third shift and do hereby recommend that the positions receive 40¢ per hour more than the Patrolman classification, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, We the Committees on Salary and Personnel and Law Enforcement, do hereby recommend that two (2) Sargeant classifications be created and that the Jail Coordinator position be eliminated in the Iowa County Sheriff's Department effective January 1, 1995 and be evaluated after a six month trial period.
