## RESOLUTION NO. 11

Designating The Sauk County Public And Environmental Health Committee As the Joint Commission For Airport Zoning For The Tri-County Airport

WHEREAS, the Counties of Richland, Sauk and Iowa own the Tri-County Airport near Lone Rock and it has become necessary at this point for an airport zoning ordinance to be adopted dealing with land uses in the vicinity of the airport in order for the airport to qualify for Federal funding for various airport improvements that are contemplated; and

WHEREAS, airport zoning poses special legal problems because of the fact that airport zoning will override and supersede whatever existing, local zoning might already be in place and so there are special provisions in section 114.136, Wisconsin Statutes, which set forth how airport zoning ordinances are to be enacted; and

WHEREAS, there are two alternate methods set forth in section 114.136(1), Wisconsin Statutes, for starting the airport zoning process when the airport is owned by a combination of municipalities, and what appears to be the most appropriate of these alternatives is found in section 114.136(1)(c) and this alternative will be satisfied by the adoption of this resolution by the County Boards of Richland, Sauk and Iowa Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Richland and Iowa County Board of Supervisors have adopted resolutions designating the Sauk County Public and Environmental Health Committee, in accordance with the provisions of section 114.136(1)(c), Wisconsin Statutes, to act as the joint commission for airport zoning for the Tri-County Airport.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sauk County Board of Supervisors, met in regular session, that the Sauk County Public and Environmental Health Committee be designated, in accordance with Section 114.136(1)(c), Wisconsin Statutes, as the Joint Commission for Airport Zoning for the Tri-County Airport located near Lone Rock.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be effective only upon adoption of a like Resolution by the County Boards of Iowa and Richland Counties.
