Stats., means a town, village, city, county, public inland lake protection and rehabilitation district, town sanitary district created under s. 60.71 or 60.72, metropolitan sewerage district created under s. 60.71, or metropolitan sewerage district created under s. 66.22 or 66.882, joint sewerage system created under s. 144.07(4), school district or vocational, technical and adult education district.)

The chairman and clerk of the county will perform all necessary actions to fully carry out the provisions of Chapter 24 and Sec. 67.12(12), Wis. Stats., and these resolutions.
