ORDINANCE NO. 2-695 - 1995

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF CITATIONS FOR CERTAIN ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS

- WHEREAS, Section 66.119 of the Wisconsin Statutes provides that the governing body of any county may by ordinance adopt and authorize the use of a citation to be issued for violations of certain ordinances:
- WHEREAS, the Iowa County Zoning Administrator and Iowa County Sanitarian believes enforcement of the Iowa County Zoning, Floodplain, Shoreline, Subdivision and Sanitary Ordinances may be made more effective and efficient by implementation of a citation procedure for violation of said ordinances;
- NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. AUTHORITY.

Citations may be issued by the Iowa County Zoning Administrator and Iowa County Sanitarian for violation of the Iowa County Zoning, Floodplain, Shoreline, Subdivision and Sanitary Ordinances.

Section 2. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY.

The above-named officials who are granted the authority to issue citations may delegate the authority to employes. The authority delegated to an official or employe shall be revoked in the same manner by which it is conferred.

Section 3. RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER LAWS.

The adoption and authority for use of a citation shall not preclude the governing body from adopting any other ordinance or providing for the enforcement of any other law or ordinance relating to the same or any other matter.

Section 4. DISCRETION.

The above-named officials and/or employes shall in their sole discretion determine whether enforcement for said zoning violations shall be by issuance of citation or by formal summons and civil forfeiture complaint issued by the Iowa County District Attorney's Office.

Section 5. PENALTY.

Any person, firm or corporation who is issued a citation under the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and costs of prosecution for each violation. Each day a violation exists or continues shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The herein ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and posting.
