Resolution No. 27-596

- WHEREAS there is recognized a need to clarify the requirements concerning the multiple use of a common right of way in the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance;
- WHEREAS the Ordinance provides for only two users of a common right of way;
- WHEREAS there is concern by Townships in Iowa County that this provision results in the discouragement of common accesses versus creating new accesses;
- WHEREAS Town Policies exist which promote the use of common accesses where possible to minimize the number of accesses along public roadways;
- WHEREAS it is recognized that the present Ordinance provision seems to contradict these Town Policies;
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors that the following be added to Section 6.3 of the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance:

"<u>Multiple Use</u>: No driveway shall allow more than four users. All multiple use driveways must have a maintenance agreement between the landowner and each user of the driveway recorded with the Iowa County Register of Deeds."
