- 4. Enhance communication within Iowa County.
- 5. Implement and make available Broadband in rural areas of the County.
- 6. Strengthen awareness of Diversity within Iowa County by providing training opportunities, signage and increase recruitment advertisement.
- 7. Work with surrounding counties on collaboration of services.
- 8. Facilitate property transfer of the old Law Enforcement to Southwest Technical College.
- 9. Support Highway Department in reducing County road miles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the 2023 County Administrators future items of challenges shall be addressed before the end of this eighth year.
