

RESOLUTION NO. 17

TO THE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, Governor Thompson has signed into law Assembly Bill 1152 amending s. 758.19(5), Wisconsin Statutes which transfers the reporting of certain court costs from the Director of State Courts to the Department of Administration (DOA), and

WHEREAS, Iowa County is eligible for reimbursement of \$43,922.00 for actual costs that the county incurred in the previous calendar year for juror fees, witness and expert witness fees, guardian ad litem fees, and salary and fringe benefits for the Judicial Assistant position. If less than the \$43,922.00 is expended, the county can only retain the amount actually spent on the above court costs for the previous year, and

WHEREAS, the Register in Probate can be a dual position which will include the duties of a Judicial Assistant and the Register in Probate under the state statutes,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that We, the Committee on Salary and Personnel, do hereby recommend that the position of Judicial Assistant/Register in Probate be created effective January 1, 1994 and the salary for the position be set at \$20,556.00.
