

IOWA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 16-595

Whereas many County Nursing Homes require a tax levy in order to operate and

Whereas reductions in the funding of the State's Medicaid Program may cause further tax levies and

Whereas the losses County Nursing Homes experience are eligible for reimbursement through the Intergovernmental Transfer Program (ITP) and

Whereas the State is claiming the losses of all County Nursing Homes in order to obtain full Federal reimbursement under the Medicare Upper Limit and

Whereas the State is returning only a portion of these County dollars to counties and

Whereas the return of these dollars would result in a direct reduction of the County Tax Levies.

Now, therefore be it resolved that Iowa County go on record and insist that the State of Wisconsin return all monies claimed under the Intergovernmental Transfer Program and

Be it further resolved, that the State maximizes the amount to be claimed up to the Medicare Upper Limit.

(Fiscal Note: Approximately \$48 million dollars for Fiscal Year '93, '94, '95 & '96 of County losses is not planned on being returned.)
