

RESOLUTION NO. 30-596

WHEREAS Iowa County has joined with the Counties of Grant and Richland and the Village of Muscoda in creation of the Muscoda Solid Waste Commission, a commission formed pursuant to sec. 66.30, Stats., for the purpose of operating a waste-to-energy facility located in Muscoda, Wisconsin,

WHEREAS said waste-to-energy facility was construction but has not been operational since 1990,

WHEREAS it is reasonable to conclude that the waste-to-energy facility will not be operational in the future for the purpose of incineration of solid waste and the facility itself is in a state of significant disrepair, and


WHEREAS it is appropriate to take steps to dispose of all or a portion of the facility to minimize additional economic losses relating to the facility and to minimize any liability that may arise from the present condition of the facility,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Iowa County hereby authorizes and directs the Executive Committee of the Muscoda Solid Waste Commission to prepare plans and recommendations for disposition of the waste-to-energy facility, either in whole or in part, with said plans and recommendations to be presented to the County Boards of Iowa, Grant and Richland Counties and the Village Board of the Village of Muscoda for their approval; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Iowa County further authorizes and directs the Executive Committee of the Muscoda Solid Waste Commission to prepare the agreements or amendments to agreements that are necessary to allow partial or complete disposition of the waste-to-energy facility, with such agreements or amendments to be presented to the County Boards of Iowa, Grant and Richland Counties and the Village Board of the Village of Muscoda for their approval.
