

RESOLUTION NO. 5-196

AMENDING STATUTE REQUIREMENT FOR NON-BOARD MEMBERS
SERVING ON COUNTY HEALTH COMMITTEES

WHEREAS, The 1993-94 Statutes mandate that the counties include public members on the County Health Committee; and

WHEREAS, Iowa County has complied with this law by appointing three (3) public persons to serve on said committee without per diem compensation or voting privileges, but with mileage reimbursement; and


WHEREAS, the present public members have asked to be relieved of their committee duties before their terms end and they have been less than diligent in attendance at committee meetings; and

WHEREAS, this particular statute has not been useful to the county and has the effect of being an unfunded mandate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors hereby requests of the GOVERNOR and the LEGISLATURE that the said statute be amended to give the counties an option to provide per diem for public members serving on county health committees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Honorable Governor: TOMMY G. THOMPSON, area State Senator and Representatives and Wisconsin Counties Association.
