

RESOLUTION NO. 8-0520

Resolution Recommending Transfer of Funds from the Iowa County Capital Projects Fund Balance for Law Enforcement Next Generation 911 System – Radio Upgrade Expenditures in 2019

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, when the County Board approved the Capital Improvement Plan for the 2018 Budget and it included funds for phase one of the Sheriff’s Department Radio Upgrade, and;

WHEREAS, due to delays in the project the expenses for phase one of the Radio Upgrade project were not completed until 2019 and the amount allocated in the 2018 project was returned to the Capital Projects fund balance, and;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Executive Committee does hereby recommend to the Iowa County Board of Supervisors a transfer of funds from the Iowa County Capital Projects Fund Balance to cover the expenses for phase one of the Law Enforcement Next Generation 911 System – Radio Project Expenditures in Excess of Budget by Department in the following 2019 account:
