

**RESOLUTION NO. 5-0521**

**RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE IOWA COUNTY COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS, & BOARDS STRUCTURE**

**WHEREAS**, the Health and Human Services Subcommittee of the Iowa County Board has received a request from the Bloomfield Commission to make certain changes to the roles and responsibilities of the Bloomfield Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bloomfield Commission is currently responsible for providing "Vision for operation, improvements, maintenance, priority setting, identifying unmet service needs and opportunities, assists in budget development in support of priorities and ongoing monitoring, assessment of services and programs, and communicating the value of services and programs to the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors has considered the future of the Bloomfield Health and Rehabilitation facility for many years; and

**WHEREAS**, while consideration has been given to the future of the building, the future of the services, and the potential for merger with other service providers; the facility has not had a clear vision or dollars invested in the structural maintenance of the facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the Health and Human Services Committee finds that the Bloomfield Commission is unfairly tasked with visioning and the responsibilities for implementation and monitoring of said vision without recent direction from the County Board.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors that while the County Board, the Health and Human Services Subcommittee, and the Nursing Home Planning Committee discuss and debate the issue of what changes to make to the Bloomfield Health and Rehabilitation Center, the said duties of the Bloomfield Commission are hereby suspended. The Health and Human Services Committee will address any questions or concerns previously under the Bloomfield Commission purview.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Bloomfield Commission's sole responsibility shall be the management of the Campbell Fund. The Commission shall meet on an "as needed" basis in order to govern said investments prudently.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all former duties of the Bloomfield Commission shall be reinstated when the County Board adopts a resolution directing said reinstatement.
