

RESOLUTION NO. 13-622

Resolution Recommending Transfer of Funds in 2022 from the Iowa County General Fund Balance to the Capital Projects Fund for the Cost of an Appraisal of the Old Sheriff's Office and Jail Property

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department has moved into the new Law Enforcement Center; thus, leaving the old sheriff's office and jail vacant; and

WHEREAS, the Long Range Planning Committee is recommending an appraisal (with and without the building) of the old sheriff's office and jail property; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Long Range Planning Committee does hereby recommend to the Iowa County Board of Supervisors a transfer of funds from the Iowa County General Fund Balance in the amount of \$10,000 to cover the appraisal cost (with and without the building) for the old sheriff's office and jail property in the following 2022 account:

Jail/Sheriff Building – Capital




