RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 20-1202
ESTABLISHING THE
OPIOID SETTLEMENT TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, Iowa County established an Opioid Settlement Task Force on February 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Iowa County has begun to receive opioid settlement funding from various litigation efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Board would like to expand the membership of the existing Opioid Settlement Task Force to increase public and professional participation and input.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors hereby modifies and expands the Opioid Settlement Task Force as follows:

1. Adding four additional members to the existing nine for a total of thirteen members
 - a. Add one additional County Supervisor for a total of three.
 - b. Add one additional representative from an Iowa County school district wholly or partially located in Iowa County for a total of two.
 - c. Add one representative from Upland Hills Health, representing medical providers of Iowa County.
 - d. Add one citizen member to increase community representation to three members.
2. Said Task Force shall prioritize spending options for the opioid settlement funding, knowing that additional funding is forthcoming and that not all priorities will be immediately funded. Task Force shall also present said priorities to Iowa County Health and Human Services Committee once established.


