What's new this week?

Epidemiology: The metric remains green as our case positivity rate is 1.45% this week. Our case rate remains steady with an average of approximately a new case each day. The incidence rate is 0.92% with 13 positives over the past 14 days. The Outbreak metric remains red with two active outbreaks.

Healthcare Status: Testing rate remains green with an average of 42.8 tests being done each day. This remains a good bit above the goal of 35 tests per day. Our partners in health care remain in green status.

Public Health Status: Community spread metric remains red as 46% of recent cases have no known exposure. This is slightly better than last week (50%). Our contact tracing and lab reporting timeliness metric remains green and improved slightly, 92% vs. 86% last week.

Emergency Management: Our emergency management partners remains in green status.
