What’s new this week?

Epidemiology: Our percentage of positive cases is 23.3%, remaining red. The average cases reported daily metric is 43. The Outbreak metric is red.

Healthcare Status: Testing rate is green with an average of 186 tests performed daily. We encourage anyone with symptoms to contact their health care provider to be tested. Local health care partner’s facility use status (represents med surge and ICU capacity) is yellow. Staffing status indicates the number of available staff to care for the volume of patients and remains red. Critical supply status reflects at least fourteen days worth of supplies. This metric remains green. Our regional health care infrastructure metric represents regional hospital bed use and is yellow. Currently there are 86.5% of regional hospital beds in use. In addition, 85.8% of total regional ICU beds are in use.

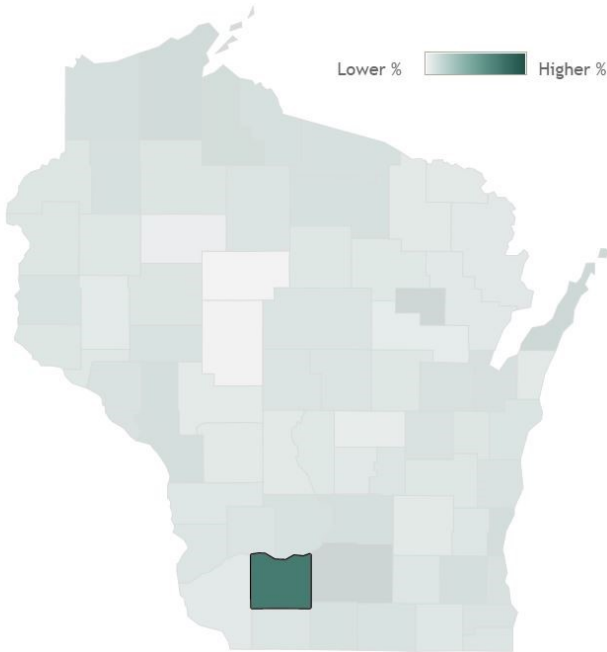

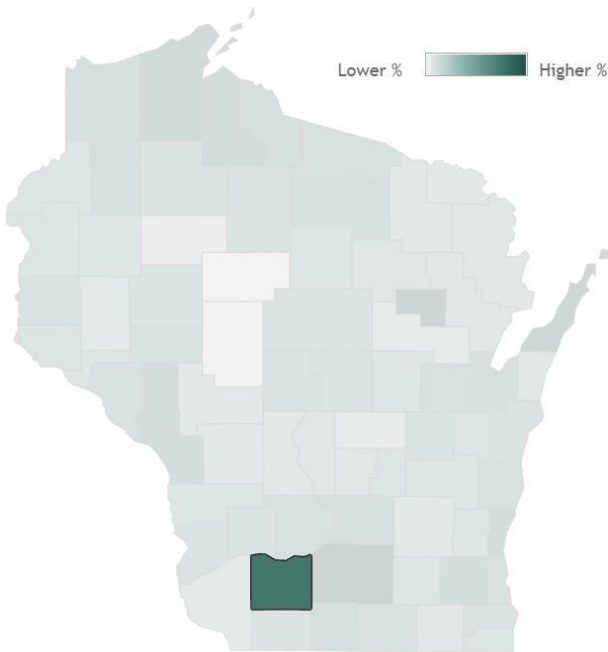
