What’s new this week?

Epidemiology: Our percentage of positive cases decreased to 3.5%, changing to green. The average cases reported daily metric decreased to 2.8, remaining red. The Outbreak metric remains red.

Healthcare Status: Testing rate is green with an average of 80 tests performed daily. We encourage anyone with symptoms to contact their health care provider to be tested. Local health care partner’s facility use status (represents med surge and ICU capacity) remains green. Staffing status indicates the number of available staff to care for the volume of patients and remains yellow. Critical supply status reflects at least fourteen days worth of supplies. This metric remains green. Our regional health care infrastructure metric represents regional hospital bed use and is yellow. Currently there are 85.5% of regional hospital beds in use, down from last week. In addition, 82.2% of total regional ICU beds are in use, also down from last week.

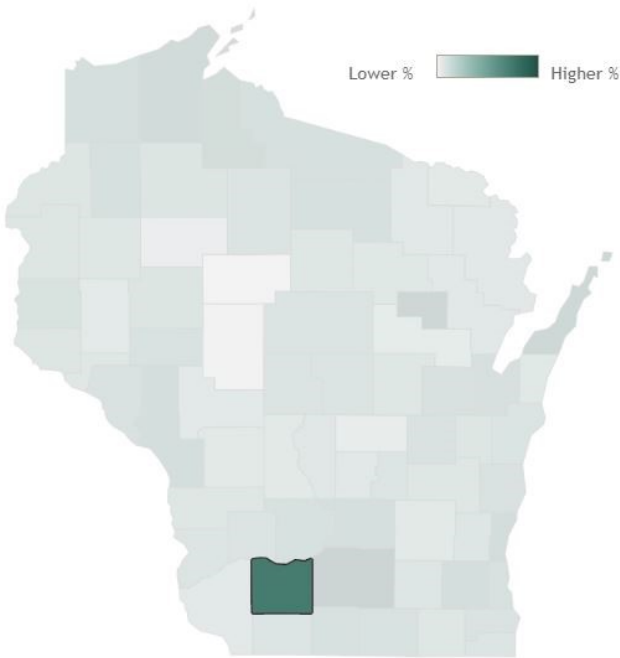

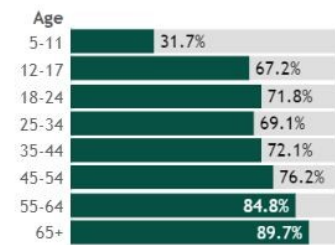

Percent of Wisconsin residents who have received at least one dose by county

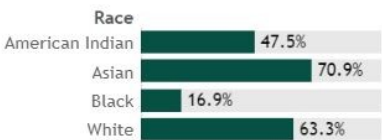

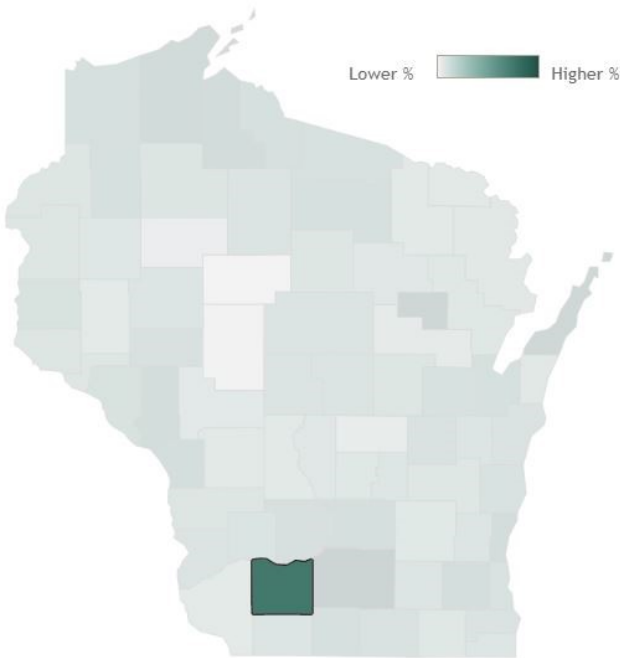

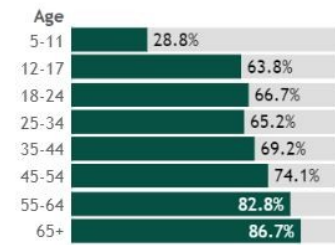

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Percent of Wisconsin residents who have completed the vaccine series by county

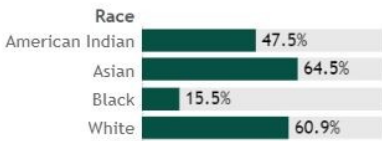
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Percent of Iowa County residents who have completed the vaccine series

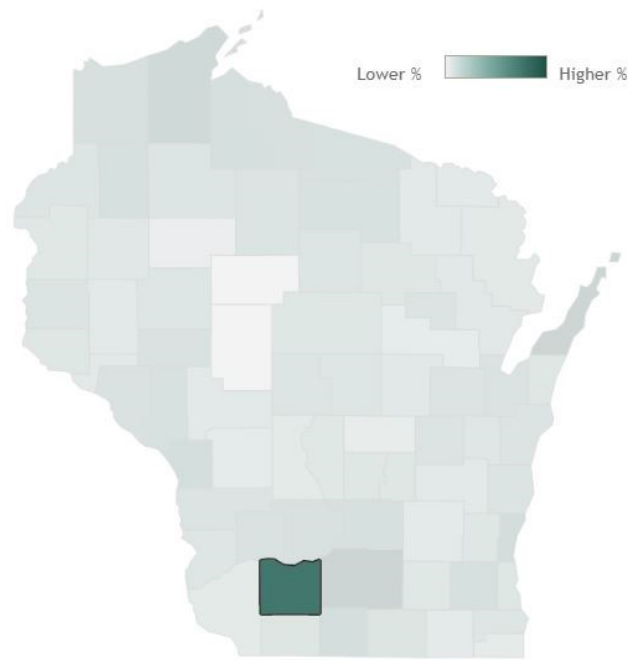
