COVID 19 and Our Pets

Iowa County -

At this time, there is no evidence that animals play a significant role in spreading the virus that causes COVID-19. Based on the limited information available to date, the risk of animals spreading COVID-19 to people is considered to be low. A small number of pets have been reported to be infected with the virus that causes COVID-19, mostly after contact with people with COVID-19. We need to learn more about how this virus affects animals. Until then, treat pets as you would other human family members to protect them from getting sick: https://bit.ly/2x73KKQ

While CDC recommends that you avoid dog parks, if you still decide to use the dog park take extra precautions including:
