Guidance to Continue to Protect Iowa County Against COVID 19

lowa County – As the Safer at Home Order has been overturned, it is critical we continue to understand that risk still remains for everyone in our community for contracting COVID 19. The virus is just as contagious and dangerous as it has been since the beginning of the pandemic. It is critical we continue with essential preventative measures in our community.

The lowa County Health Department, Emergency Management and Sheriff's Department want to reiterate the need for residents to continue taking the necessary steps to protect the health and safety of themselves, their families and community. We continue to commend the residents of lowa County for the efforts made with public health efforts to slow the spread of COVID 19. We have been successful in slowing the spread and flattening the curve in lowa County and we want to continue to keep residents safe and healthy.

We also continue to expect and trust that businesses will take responsibility to protect the health of their employees and customers and assist in the prevention and transmission of COVID-19. Businesses and consumers are encouraged to follow the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) guidelines https://wedc.org/reopen-guidelines/. If we proceed too quickly and do not follow the guidance, we will be at risk for a rapid increase in cases.

The lowa County Health Department has created a Business Toolkit which can be found at https://www.iowacounty.org/departments/COVID-19 to be used as an additional tool to help businesses in their ability to open and operate safety.

Please remember, Iowa County has many residents who are at greater risk for serious health concerns when exposed to COVID-19. It is advised that individuals over age 60 or those with underlying health conditions continue to stay home as much as possible. This virus doesn't spread itself. People spread it. We don't have a cure or a vaccine yet. Our best tool is isolation for those we know are sick and physically distancing ourselves from others. Each of us represents an opportunity to interrupt the transmission of this virus. The lowa County Health Department will continue to keep you up to date on information that impacts our community.

It is important to continue to take the following steps to protect yourself and others from COVID-19:

- Stay home as much as possible and if you are sick.
- Minimize physical contact with anyone outside of your household.

- Maintain 6 feet of distance between yourself and others if you need to go out.
- Minimize travel, especially to areas considered to be "viral hot spots" within and beyond our state borders.
- Practice good hygiene:
 - o Wash your hands regularly for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
 - O Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow.
 - Avoid touching your face.
- Wear a fabric face covering when you must be in public.
