Dropping off your unused and expired medications is fast and easy.

Place pills or capsules in a zip-top bag, without the container. Dispose of the container after you have removed and destroyed the label. If you have liquids, gels or creams, please leave those in their original containers (black out personal information on the label) and place them in a zip-top bag. There is no limit to the amount of drugs that can be brought and no questions will be asked of whoever brings them.

What you can dispose of in the Drop Box:

- Prescription medicine (pills, liquids and creams)
- Over the counter medicine (pills, liquids and creams)
- Medications for pets
- Vitamins
- Nebulizer solution
- Medication samples



Do not dispose in the Drop Box:

- IV bags
- Oxygen tanks
- Nebulizer machines
- Thermometers
- Inhalers
- Sharps, epi pens or anything with a needle or lance
(These can be disposed at Hometown Pharmacy or taken to Upland Hills Health, in a hard plastic container)



Remember, you should never dispose of your medications in the trash or down the drain.
