


THE AGRICULTURE SECTOR BENEFITS THE ENTIRE COUNTY

Livestock and dairy sales produce 62% of total county ag income, dominated by commodity dairy and beef production. Seventy-seven percent of Iowa County's 1500 farms have less than \$100,000 in sales. While still largely rural, Iowa County counts as a Metropolitan Statistical Area with Madison and Dane County. This proximity and commutability to Madison creates challenges and opportunities for agriculture. Demand for rural ag land for lifestyle farms creates competition for existing farmland. New farm entrants are focusing on higher profit margin farm products which appeal to changing millennial consumers tastes and require a smaller land base.
