General Review Process

Before any application can be approved, the underlying zoning of the affected property must permit nonmetallic mining as a permitted land use. This may involve the applicant needing to first seek zoning and/or conditional use permit approval before this application can be acted upon.

This application review process will involve:

- Staff review of completeness of the application information
- Staff review of the required reclamation plan (or revision of an existing plan, where applicable)
- Staff review of the proposed financial assurance amount and form
- Staff determines if the underlying land use permits the mining activity
- Staff shall publish a public notice within 30 days after the application is deemed complete that:
 - Briefly describes the mining and reclamation planned at the site
 - Mentions the opportunity for public hearing pursuant to NR135.20 WI Adm Rules
 - Gives the locations at which the public may review the application and all supporting materials, including the reclamation plan

***This notice is satisfied should there be a public hearing associated with land use (zoning) approval and, at that time, there is opportunity provided to the public to provide testimony on reclamation-related matters*

- Action by the Iowa County Planning & Zoning Committee on the application, reclamation plan and financial assurance
